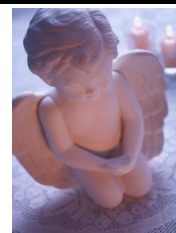

The catechism administration is a voluntary ministry. Transfer of cash and paperwork across catechism groups is the parent/guardian's responsibility. 1. Mass and Class is a composite unit. Children missing mass are considered absent unless prior permission is secured from the catechism administration office. 2. If the child is absent more than 4 classes in the year, they could risk repeating the year, especially sacrament classes. 3. Termwise and annual assessments are carried out to assess the knowledge and understanding of the child, movement to the next class is subject to this assessment. A complete set of guidelines will be emailed and sent to all parents once classes commence.
